Supervising Officer Assigned Date of Ride-Along
A significant portion of a Nome Police Officer's day consists of contact with the public. We
require our personnel to dress professionally in the performance of their duties. As a rider, the
public will not differentiate you from a member of the Nome Police Department. As such, we
request that you dress in reasonable attire which is appropriate for the weather conditions.
Due to the nature of the duties of the Nome Police Department, you are encouraged to bring any
personal items you may need for the duration of an entire ten or twelve - hour shift and to have
an alternate plan for emergency transportation in the unlikely event the supervising Officer must
put you out of the patrol car or unexpectedly need to cancel the ride-along.
Not all information is 'public' information. While participating on a ride-a-long, you may be
exposed to information that is not for public dissemination. Information sensitive to an
investigation, names of victims and details of events, obtained during a ride-a-long, will not be
released without Departmental approval. The unauthorized release of confidential
information could violate state and federal laws or subject you to civil action.
Generally during the ride-a-long you will be able to shadow the Officer. However, there are a
few exceptions. As a member of the public, you may not follow an Officer into a private
residence or onto private property without the owner's approval. You may not make audio/video
recordings of any person, or take photographs. This includes NPD staff. If the Officer you are
with deems a situation unsafe for any reason, you must follow the Officer's directions and go to
a safe location specified by the Officer.
There is a possibility that you may ultimately be called as a witness to testify to things you
observe while riding with an Officer.
