**A RESOLUTION FROM THE NOME PLANNING COMMISSION
RECOMMENDING THE COMMON COUNCIL APPROVE THE NOME
LOCAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN UPDATE**

WHEREAS: the City of Nome recognizes the threat that all hazards pose to people and property; and

WHEREAS: undertaking hazard mitigation actions before disasters occur will reduce potential for harm to people and property and save taxpayer dollars; and

WHEREAS: an adopted local hazards mitigation plan is required as a condition of future grant funding for mitigation projects; and

WHEREAS: the Nome Local Hazards Mitigation Plan was approved in 2003 and the federal government requires that the plan be updated every five years; and

WHEREAS: the Nome Planning Commission held public meetings on the plan on the plan update, distributed the plan to the public and provided a copy of the plan update on the city website; and

WHEREAS: the Division of Homeland Security & Emergency Services and the Federal Emergency Management Agency approve the plan update on May 7, 2008, subject to final approval by the City of Nome.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Nome Planning Commission recommends that the Nome Common approve the Nome Hazard Mitigation Plan.
