RESOLUTION NO. R-20-12-02 (amended)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NOME AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT PHASE VI OF CARES ACT FUNDING FOR BUSINESSES AND INDIVIDUALS IMPACTED BY COVID-19

WHEREAS, the City of Nome declared a state of emergency on March 17, 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic; and,

WHEREAS, the Nome Common Council has repeatedly affirmed this state of emergency and extended emergency powers to the City Manager until December 31, 2020; and,

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic has presented the community of Nome with operating challenges; and

WHEREAS, the City of Nome has released five rounds of funding for COVID-19 relief to businesses, carvers, and residents in Nome; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Nome wishes to release a sixth round of CARES Act relief funds to the community of Nome for those employees and businesses specifically affected by Ordinance No. O-20-11-01 which limited revenue opportunities for Restaurants, bars, and taxi companies since November 25, 2020;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Nome Common Council authorizes the City Manager to implement an additional round of CARES Act funding for restaurant and bar workers and cab drivers in the following amounts:

Employees:

Part-time (less than 20 hours per week) - \$300.00 per week assistance Full-time (20 hours + per week) - \$600.00 per week assistance Maximum of five weeks to be applied for.

Business (based on 2019 sales tax records):

60 percent of the average November and December 2019 revenues of qualified business with a maximum benefit of \$10,000.
